The Workshop

The one-day workshop, per couple, costs \$900 plus materials for weekdays and \$980 plus materials for Saturdays/Sundays.

Step-by-step tuition and demonstrations, photos of your experience and lunch are included.

How The Wedding Ring Experience Works

Before you decide whether this is the experience for you, you can book a consultation with Peter to discuss your wedding ring needs. Peter will go through different styles and materials with you and your partner, so you really can make a ring that is perfect for you.

Some designs, such as fitted wedding rings may need to be carved from wax and cast after your visit and Peter can explain this to you during the consultation. As a master jeweller, Peter is able to set stones into your wedding rings once you have made them as the icing on the cake.

Peter will provide you with a written quote, which is valid for three months, which will give you time to decide if the experience is right for you. If you decide to proceed, Peter will arrange a date for you to come and create your wedding rings.

To confirm your date, a 30% deposit is required.

The Wedding Ring Experience is unique to Western Australia and operates from Perth's only private jewellery school, Contemporary Metal.

On the day

1. The day starts at 9:30am with a cup of tea or coffee, and a briefing of your step-by-step tasks.
2. Now the fun begins! You will form the metal into the correct profile and cut to the right length (nervous students can practice of base metal first).
3. You will then form the metal into the ring shape, and solder it together using the skills Peter has taught you.
4. A well deserved lunch.
5. After lunch you can then focus on work hardening and filing the shape into the rings.
6. The final stage is finishing and polishing.
7. If your rings do not require casting, engraving or stone setting, you can take them home with you.
8. It is not time for a celebratory drink while we view the photos of your experience.
9. The Wedding Ring Experience usually takes between five and seven hours.
